## Reports:

## City:

- Hazel is looking into the cost and feasibility of using repurposed bus shelters as shelters in the parks. They are currently made with tempered glass and the cost to replace with plexiglass would be \$1850 plus \$500 for installation. There will be a cost from the city to pour concrete pads. Oakville uses tempered glass. There will be sponsorship possibilities available with the shelters as well. LFM will discuss and report back to Hazel. The item was referred to one of the working groups.
- Parks Planning: The city is currently considering 2 new parks for City Centre. Bud Cleary
  or Zonton Meadows. There may be a temporary area set up for the next 5 years with
  the plan being for Zonton Meadows to become the permanent leash-free area once a
  parcel of land becomes available. Fencing and costing still to be discussed and no
  digging till at least May.
- Dog Walking Permit: Passed at council very smoothly. Hazel thanked Barb and Karen for speaking. It is now with the legal department while they rewrite the bi-laws. The city is working with Animal Services and there will be an online registration for the dog walking permit in place by May. Walkers will have to register to walk 4 dogs or more to a max of 8.
- Grass cutting is currently out for tender. Hazel inquired if the current schedule still met all park needs. Once a month at each park at the end of the month, except for Toto, they are cut twice a month. The cost of Jack Darlings grass cutting will be paid for by the park this year.
