Leash-free Mississauga (LFM) is a volunteer organization to maintain the parks and liaison with the city for new parks began in 1995. We rely on membership and volunteers to fund our activities, which includes paying for hydro at some parks, and to plan and fund park enhancements.

To thank our members and supporters, we are giving out nifty sturdy poop bag dispensers which also have a flashlight attached (with ability to change batteries). Membership lists have been posted on all display boards and each park is planning to host a membership drive to distribute the dispensers to current members and to encourage all park users to join us.

Designated areas for small dogs (under 25 lbs)

Jack Darling and Toto each have fenced areas for small dogs who are more comfortable in a smaller area and interacting with dogs their own size. Small dogs are welcome at all parks of course.

Jack Darling Small Dog Park:

Spring has finally arrived! Come play, chase, wrestle or quietly wander around with 10 to 30 other similarly sized dogs. All dogs under 25 lbs are very welcome (usually greeted by several excited puppies). The grass is growing fast and thanks to the wood chips spread by all our volunteers, even on rainy days our little park is usually not too muddy.

Our busiest times are usually midafternoon and early evening. Finding a parking spot over the weekends can be challenging. Remember that there's a second parking lot on the east side of the main park. The parking enforcement bylaw officers regularly patrol our parking areas and illegally parked vehicles are ticketed. Interested in volunteering? We need a Twitter and an Instagram expert to regular update our Small Dog park accounts. With more volunteers, we can start organizing more fun events at our park.

Please think twice about using the park at night. Currently we have no lighting although we have asked the City to investigate the cost to add lighting. The number of coyote sighting here is increasing!
