City of Mississauga – Jenna Prokop:


- Visited some of the parks
- Etobicoke Valley
 - Presentation by Region of Peel on project to be scheduled for next meeting or near future
 - Region of Peel project, update received 6 weeks ago
 - Park to be shut down for 18 months
 - Tree removals to be scheduled first, 1 week closure, waiting for Forestry permit
 - Jamie working on communication plan
 - There will be signage directing to eparks.ca for alternate parks
 - Signs on gates indicating Push or Pull need replacing
 - Southern-most part of park has tree nursery with snow fence protection to protect young trees, snow fence has fallen apart, Jenna will follow up with park supervisor
- Parkway Belt fencing around pool of muddy water south side, scheduled for spring
- Quenippenon spring work planning:
 - lights and water requests, waiting for Realty team and Region of Peel feedback
 - move gate to north pathway and chicken wire fence work approved
 - move mulch outside big gate into park
 - Possible to get garbage can near north end gate of park
- Totoredaca
 - front parking lot construction, any update from Region of Peel
 - Notice board build new at back gate when starts
 - Jenna meeting end of March with some of the supervisors for Toto regarding all the community groups there (RC cars, RC flying club)
 - ♦ Complaints to bylaw about flying club have been made
 - > Flying club allowed to fly by Transport Canada
 - Not allowed directly over dog park
 - Multiple planes have come down in the park, Lady was hit in 2021
 - Possible might just be a visitor not an MMFC member or member of their group
 - Every time bylaw has visited recently after call there have been no issues by the time they arrive, plane and operator has already left the park
