#### City of Mississauga – Jenna Prokop:

- Operations going at high capacity, mainly due to recent storm
- Students have been hired by city, Garbage cans, picnic tables coming out over next few weeks
  - Let Jenna know if additional needed
- Sanitation supervisor has been updated by Jenna about our recent issues
- Etobicoke Valley
  - Updates about Region of Peel, East Trunk Sanitary Sewer Offline Storage Facility, Project Number 18-2441, planned start late 2022
  - Requested temporary park during construction, Jenna will pass on
- Garnetwood
  - Send Jenna map where to move shed away from back gate corner where lawnmower comes in, getting hit and knocked around by lawnmowers, to platform beside willow tree update, work order has been put in
  - Jenna received photos of 2 big muddy pools back by the trees to be repaired update, will put in work order
- Jack Darling
  - Update on construction Project Number: 22-1408 Emergency Watermain Repair, should be 1 day, will give 2 week notification
- Lakeside
  - Gates were checked
- Parkway Belt
  - Jenna visited, waiting on fencing quote around pool of muddy water south side
  - Boulders in parking lot that were moved, Jenna arranging to be put back
  - Parking lot needs lines to be repainted
  - Inner gate was fixed, but still problems closing properly
  - Jenna will put in work order to fix pebbles covering mud between inner and outer gates
- Quenippenon
  - Water and lighting upgrades approved but must be paid by City according to Peel Region, so city prioritizing water source first, lighting at a later date, due to budget priorities
  - Move gate to north pathway and chicken wire fence work approved and to be scheduled, being prioritized by Jamie's team
  - 2 loads mulch were brought into North entrance
  - Garbage can request near north end gate of park declined due to compactor truck cannot reach there
  - Newer benches and tables rollout ongoing, let Jenna know if not done
- Totoredaca
  - April 27 incident, 911 was called, 2 dogs interacting with 1 possibly aggressively, male visitor struck older male visitor, knocking him down, was unconscious for awhile, police made some charges, security made site visit but no known recommendations

- Planned watermain replacement, Project Number 15-1138, no update yet regarding front parking lot construction from Region of Peel, planned start late 2022, new notice board at back gate on supervisors list to do when project begins
