- Etobicoke Valley
 - Updates about Region of Peel, East Trunk Sanitary Sewer Offline Storage Facility, Project Number 18-2441, planned start late 2022
 - Project tendered, contract awarded, possible early August, update next meeting
 - No temporary park during construction, alternate parks will be posted during construction
- Garnetwood
 - Approval received to move shed away from back gate corner where lawnmower comes in, getting hit and knocked around by lawnmowers, to platform beside willow tree update, work order has been put in
 - Mulch has been delivered to cover of 2 big muddy pools back by the trees
- Jack Darling
 - Construction Project Number: 22-1408 Emergency Watermain Repair has been completed
- Lakeside: nothing to report
- Parkway Belt
 - Fencing quote approved around pool of muddy water south side, budget approved, 2 weeks to complete, will provide update
 - Boulders in parking lot that were moved have been put back into place
 - Parking lot needs lines to be repainted
 - Gates were checked and fine
 - Pebbles covering mud between inner and outer gates always get washed out onto pathway during rains by water running out of park, possible to use pavers instead
 - Jenna will review with supervisor
 - Jenna will follow up on faded street signs

 - Water source work order created for staff to plan creating water line, create project scope
 - Move gate to north pathway and chicken wire fence work approved and to be scheduled, being prioritized by Jamie's team, no update yet

 - Fence repair outstanding, dogs can escape
 - Parking lot has deep ruts, could damage cars, belongs to region, Jenna will contact

 - Grass cutting done in paths on 2nd and 3rd levels instead of entire area, some users grumble about the long grass due to ticks
 - Gate issues at entrance near washrooms, not closing properly
 - Lots of kids at the park, do others experience same
- d) Lakeside: Ellen:
 - Park is ok
 - Following up with Purina for grant cheque
- e) Parkway Belt: Carol: no issues, happy to be getting fence work done
- f) Paul Coffey: Daniel:
 - seeing more attendance
 - needs weeds, holes, concrete chunks taken care of
 - needs shed, bulletin board, water eventually
 - investigating if water might be available at tennis club
- g) Quenippenon: Laurie:
 - Spraying by city dramatically improved gypsy moth situation
 - Mulch deliveries continue to be made in locations outside the park, creates extra work manual labour for members to move mulch inside
 - Looking forward to getting chicken wire fence replaced and gates moved
 - One bench is unsafe and will be moved outside
 - Fence repair needed where dogs can escape
 - Shed has sunk down into ground, unable to open in the winter, needs to be raised up, and needs new hinges
 - Mulch deliveries and volunteer spreading has greatly reduced mud during bad weather
- h) Totoredaca: Bob:
 - Requested 2 loads of fill to fix holes
 - Would like to be notified when city staff visit to meet in person, including forestry, grass-cutting, gates, and security
