- Reviewed financials
- Winter hats were purchased \$2,006.88 for volunteers passed out by park reps
- IT cost increase includes boosting facebook earlier in 2022; website improvements would be planned
- No road sign expense this year, was last year to promote membership
- Expenses covered by city include water, grass cutting, fence and gate repairs
- New city-approved lighting would be planned
- Cash amounts unspent discussed, covid has affected planning last 2 years
- Questions to Directors
 - Member from Jack Darling asked about sign prohibiting **Pit Bulls**

- this is from the Ontario Dog Owners' Liability Act, Pit Bull Ban, which is still in effect, however dogs are not longer seized just based on how they look; sign placed by city, not LFM
- Signs say "The Leash-Free Zone is subject to the Dog Owners' Liability Act, RSO 1990 as amended", and "Any Dog(s), including but not limited to Pitbulls, under provincial or municipal muzzle orders must be muzzled while in the Leash-Free Zone"
- Potential member from Quenippenon appreciates Park Rep asked about water and shelter and newer benches
 - Quenippenon is owned by Peel region and leased back to city, improvement requests are working through the approval processes
 - Signing up for membership on LFM website helps us ask for things, growing memberships helps
- Potential member without park nearby asked about plans to create more parks
 - Encouraged members and potential members to join monthly board meetings to participate and understand the process of working with the city to create new parks, work with city councillors, etc.
- Member from Jack Darling asked about pebble stones on pathways which are very muddy, gravel is hard on dog's paws
 - o Ticket is in with the city to spread on pathways
 - Gravel is no longer put in parks, but Jack Darling is grandfathered in due to long pathways

 - Holes and gaps in fences, notified city for possible walk-around
 - Stepping down, looking for replacement Park Rep, interested members please attend Dec/22 meeting
 - Portion of park is closed until end of November
- Lakeside: Ellen:
 - Park is good, woodchips to be delivered over next 2 weeks to be spread by volunteers
 - Appreciation given to all Lakeside volunteers past and present
- Parkway Belt: Carol:
 - Gates are an ongoing issue, one repaired last week, already broken again, replacements needed
 - Work gates facing Eglinton have gaps, small dogs can escape, work order submitted
- Paul Coffey: Daniel:
 - Appreciation given for accepting him as Park rep and on the board
 - Working a lot with the city
 - Has had day where 17 dogs were present
 - 19 new LFM members
 - New shed installed, shared bin, bag share
 - City will continue to improve the park next year, planning to expand as much as they can, will remove a big berm that secludes the park
 - New parking lot closer to the park planned with lighting
 - In ground poop disposal planned
 - Water line planned
 - Pathway with lighting and signage planned
 - Always looking for volunteers to help out
- Quenippenon: Laurie:
 - 2 piles of mulch delivered outside of the park, forcing volunteers to drag the mulch through the gates into the park
 - Chicken wire fence, small dog area and gate between North and South side construction timing not known
